

they had several interested parties wanting to join them in the proposed space. The project grew to a three story medical office building anchored by Dr. Knighton's practice. Freeport Osteopathic Health, Nordx, and a Central Maine Medical Center pediatric practice, opening in September, joined the Freeport Medical Center in the building. It is rewarding to see the property professionally developed and it was an honor to be part of the process.

Project Spotlight

Island Art Studios

Two successful artists approached us to design and build individual art studios on their summer island. This has been a dream, long in the making for them, and we are thrilled to be on board with this project. The coordination and transportation of materials for this project were one of the biggest challenges.

The project was completed in two phases with the first being the site clearing and



construction of the two decks. The second phase involved a barge service delivering all the materials from the mainland and a helicopter service to lift and set each carefully weighed and labeled bundle of materials at the building sites. Once all the materials arrived, the crew worked long days to raise and finish the timber framed studios. Each studio was designed to the artist's specifications for lighting, window placement, door

openings, and storage.

We had a student film crew capture the process, which we plan to share <u>online</u> soon. We are confident that these finished studios will provide ongoing inspiration for these highly talented artists. *Stay tuned....*
