“Overlooking the Kennebec tidal estuary, this Dutch colonial home helped draw two world travelers back to Maine. The original builder had salvaged vintage hand-hewn beams, along with old bricks and a pot hook and bread oven, to create a room with a generous hearth and an Old World atmosphere. We refurbished the bricks, beams, and mantelpiece and installed wood floors, but otherwise left the room intact. Hung over the mantel, Erin McGee Ferrell’s abstract painting of Martin’s Point Bridge in Falmouth echoes the room’s hefty beams while adding a modern twist.”
